It is always actively involved in helping the students in furtherance of achieving their goal of becoming CA. Being a CA, not only professionally we should excel but personally too we should cater our image as good and responsible citizen of India. Hence, it’s just our (Vapi Branch of WICASA) efforts to bring out the talent within you and make you realize what you are and what you could be.

A. Eligibility Criteria:

The festival is open to the students CPT, IPCC who are undergoing articleship and also students in respect of whom two years have not been lapsed after the completion of articles and CA. FINAL students. All are invited to grace the occasion as well as are eligible to participate in this festival.

(Please carry the application copy of registration letter issued by ICAI / Student’s ID Card / Admit Card issued by ICAI supported by one of the photo id proof issued by Government)

- B. Registration will be on “first come first serve” basis. All the entries should compulsorily route through **submitting online form** link of which is provided on www.vapi-icai.org → Announcements, after going through below Rules.
- C. In case if number of entries are more than required then eliminations will be made by **Auditions on 15/12/2013** (for **CPT Students** taking test in December 2013 on 22/12/2013) at Vapi Branch Premises.
- D. Any particular events listed below may be held subject to minimum number of participants.
- E. In case of any discrepancy or misunderstanding decision of WICASA Committee shall be final and binding on all the participants.

- F. Students will be allowed to participate, **only in 1 competition from Morning Events and max. 3 competitions, in all the respect, from Evening Events.**
- G. In all the below events / competitions wherever applicable, selection process for prize distribution and their categories of winners', rights are reserved with Judges for the event. Their decision shall be final and binding on all.
- H. All the participants (including all members in case of group) will have to be present by 2.00 pm alongwith their respective music tracks on CD's or Pendrives. Further, it is the responsibility of the respective participants to get their event synchronized with DJ of event.
- I. **In case of Group entries, any one participant / leader should fill the form by giving the names of others students and registration number in the appropriate fields provided in online form.**
- J. Each participants will be allowed to fill and submit **ONLY ONE FORM**, by selecting the category / ies of competition of their choice. (Refer point "F")
- K. **Last date for submission of names / entries is 12/12/13.**
- L. "SAMARTHA" being diverse in nature comprises of many competitions. The whole competition is categorized into Morning Events and Evening Events.
1. **Highlights of Morning Events and Rules thereto (participants can take part in any of the ONE event from this category);**
 - I. **Fine Art:** This is competition for Art Lovers. There are 2 sub competitions -
 - a. Theme based Painting, on topic [Say No to Tobacco or Go Green]-
 - i. It can be made either on drawing sheet or T-Shirt. The drawing sheet and T-Shirt will be provided by Vapi WICASA while participants will have to bring the other necessary tools.
 - ii. Poster color is to be used for drawing sheet and fabric color for T-Shirt.
 - iii. **Time given will be 60 minutes.**
 - iv. Only Individual is allowed to participate.

- II. **Blind strokes**: A blind folded drawing competition. This is also an exciting competition for art lovers.
- i. The picture has to be made on drawing sheet either by pencil strokes or brush strokes or both.
 - ii. Participant will be blind folded.
 - iii. **Time given will be 30 minutes.**
 - iv. Only Individual can participate.

Note: Any of the above paintings on T-Shirts / Drawing Sheets *may* be promoted for Ramp Walk in the evening itself or can be used in a rally of such social event to be organized by WICASA later.

- III. **Trash Can Novelities**: An event to create an art by recycling Junk.
- i. A kit having set of Junk articles / materials will be provided and the participant will have to prepare any thing or item out of it using their creativity.
 - ii. Only Individual can participate.
 - iii. **Time given will be 60 minutes.**
 - iv. Entry will be on First Come First Basis, restricted to maximum of 10 participants.
- IV. **Mehandi/Rangoli**: An event portraying Indian Tradition / Culture.
- i. Only individuals are allowed to participate both in mehandi and rangoli competition. Participant are requested to arrange for their partners on whose hands they may put mehandi.
 - ii. **Maximum time allowed will be 60 minutes.**
 - iii. The materials for both competitions will have to be brought by participants.
- V. **Out of the Box Creativity**: In this category, participants are free to express their individual skills, creativity or any work of art or craft which is not listed above.
- i. Only individuals can take part in this.
 - ii. Participant can make anything out of any material he likes or can display any of his skills or hobbies. He/she will have to bring all the materials with him/her to the competition.
 - iii. **Time given is 60 minutes.**

- iv. Selection for this particular category is solely at the discretion of WICASA Committee and shall be final and binding on all respect.

Note: For ex: any Science / Technical Project, Clay work, Sculpture, Quilling, Handicrafts.

- VI. **Fun N Masti (informal events):** Apart from above competitions displaying one's skills and hobbies students can have fun playing below games during the course of above events;
 - i. Dumb Sharas
 - ii. Live Snakes and Ladders (for the first time)
 - iii. Dart Game
 - iv. Arm Wrestling
 - v. Many more activities to keep you active.

2. Highlights of Evening Events and Rules thereto (participants can take part in any of the THREE events from this category);

- I. **Gone in Sixty Seconds / ad mad show -** The single minute extempore speech or version of Ad mad show or 60 seconds to fame;
 - i. The participants will have to enroll before hand to participate.
 - ii. Participant will have to speak on any topic or situation. He will get 10 seconds to think on it and then he will have to speak for 1 minute.
 - iii. Medium of speech may be English or hindi.
 - iv. **Or** Participant will be given a product and he will have to express how will he market or advertise that product. 30 seconds will be given for thinking and 1 minute to express.
 - v. The selection of whether to speak or advertise will be as per the draw of chits. The participant will not be given the choice.

II. **Dance events:**

III. **Raga - The Singing Event:**

Category	No. of Participants	Max. Time limit	Remarks
Solo Singing	Individual	5 min.	Track can be Hindi or English. Preferably participants will have to come with the background instrumental.
Duet Singing	2	5 min.	

- IV. **Bang Bang:** A competition of playing any musical instruments either in solo or duet or group or Band. Max. Time limit 10 mins.
- V. **Nukkad:** The competition of Dramatic events like, Drama Plays and Skits. Min. Participants should be 3. Max. Time limit 10 mins.
- VI. **Other Talent:** like Mimicry, Mono Acting, Mime or any other individual skills. In either case maximum 10 mins.
- VII. **Added Attractions:** Listed below events are not a part of competition, but interested students may give their names for gracing the occasion, we will choreograph the dance.
- Ramp Walk / Fashion Show.
 - Welcome Dance
 - Theme based Concluding Dance.

Further, added attractions like, few performances will be showcase, by group of professional dancers (will not be part of competition), A Minute to WIN it and **Live DJ dance party.**

Last but not the least, for entertainment purpose we have organized the game of **TAMBOLA**, tickets of which will have to be purchased at a nominal cost of Rs. 20/-, with lots of Cash Prizes attached there to.
